The requirements for a minor must be completed concurrently with the major degree requirements. No minor may be added by completing courses after receiving the bachelor's degree. **REQUIRED COURSES** SOC 1113, Introduction to Sociology 3 At least six (6) credit hours must be earned in courses acceptable for residence credit by standards set forth by the College of Arts and Sciences, excluding transfer, correspondence, and examination (AP, CLEP, 3 SOC 3523, Criminology Advanced Standing) credit. Courses for the minor may not be taken Pass/ No Pass. SOC 3533, Criminal Justice 3 Students must successfully complete at least 18 hours of courses acceptable for major credit in Sociology, including at least nine (9) hours at the upper-SOC 3543, Sociology of Deviance, division level. SOC 3890 will not count toward this total. SOC 3553, Sociology of Law No single course may be used by a student to satisfy a major requirement and a minor requirement. A course may be used, however, to satisfy both a major support requirement and a minor requirement. Six (6) credit hours – Two additional 3000- or 4000-level courses in Sociology, excluding Directed Readings, Independent Study, Internship courses, and courses taken Requests to substitute a minor requirement must be approved in writing through the Independent Study department: by the Department of Sociology.
