Courses for the minor may not be taken Pass/No Pass.</p> <p>Students must successfully complete at least 18 hours of courses acceptable for major credit in Women's and Gender Studies, including at least nine (9) hours at the upper-division level. Topics courses must be approved in advance by the Women's and Gender Studies academic adviser.</p> <p><i>No single course may be used by a student to satisfy a major requirement and a minor requirement.</i> A course may be used, however, to satisfy both a major support requirement and a minor requirement.</p> <p>Requests to substitute a minor requirement must be approved in writing by the Women's and Gender Studies Program.</p>
