No minor may be added by completing courses after receiving the bachelor's degree. **REQUIRED COURSES** At least six (6) credit hours must be earned in courses acceptable for residence credit by standards set forth by the College of Arts and Sciences, excluding transfer, correspondence, and examination (AP, CLEP, 3 SPAN 2113, Intermediate Spanish Advanced Standing) credit. Courses for the minor may not be taken Pass/ No Pass. SPAN 2223, Intermediate Spanish Continued 3 Students must successfully complete at least 18 hours of courses in 3 Spanish, including at least 12 hours at the upper-division level. Note SPAN 3073, Grammar in Conversational Communication that introductory courses (SPAN 1115 and 1225) are not counted 3 toward this total. SPAN 3423, Grammar in Written Communication No single course may be used by a student to satisfy a major requirement and a minor requirement. A course may be used, however, to satisfy both Two courses (6 hours) to be chosen from any 3000- or a major support requirement and a minor requirement. 4000-level Spanish course.
