<p>Required Course: ANTH 5001, Professionalization in Anthropology</p>	1	<p>The master's degree requires the equivalent of at least two semesters of satisfactory graduate work and additional work as may be prescribed for the degree.</p>
<p>Core Courses (9 hours): Students must fulfill the two-course core course sequence, as well as a core course in <u>one</u> other subfield (linguistic anthropology would be the default and highly recommended course for most students) selected in consultation with the student's advisor and committee. <i>All three Core courses must be completed with a grade of B or higher.</i></p>		<p>All coursework applied to the master's degree must carry graduate credit.</p>
<p>ANTH 5123, Contemporary Culture Theory</p> <p>ANTH 5223, Foundations of Social Thought</p>	3 3	<p>Master's degree programs which require a thesis consist of at least 30 credit hours. Credit transferred from other institutions must meet specific criteria and is subject to certain limitations.</p>
<p>Core in ONE other subfield: ANTH 5363, Linguistic Anthropology, or ANTH 6633, Method & Theory in Biological Anthropology, or ANTH 6713, Archaeological Theory</p> <p style="text-align: center;">_____</p>	3	<p>Courses completed through correspondence study may <i>not</i> be applied to the master's degree.</p>
<p>Research Methods (3 hours): ANTH 5253, Anthropology of Communities, or ANTH 5213, Ethnographic Methods</p>	3	<p>To qualify for a graduate degree, students must achieve an overall grade point average of 3.0 or higher in the degree program coursework and in all resident graduate coursework attempted. A student must also have at least a 3.0 in all coursework (including undergraduate coursework if any).</p>
<p>Thesis (2-5 hours): ANTH 5980, Research for Master's Thesis</p>	2-5	
<p>Electives (12-15 hours): 12-15 hours of coursework selected in consultation with the student's advisor and committee. No more than 6 hours from outside Anthropology may be applied.</p>
