Courses are chosen in consultation with the Honors College to develop students' cultural competence through the study of cultural variation within any humanistic, social scientific, or scientific context. Three of the 18 hours will be devoted to the study of a foreign language beyond the university's minimum 6 hour general education requirement.</p> <p>Requests to substitute a minor requirement must be approved in writing by the Honors College.</p>
