Lower division courses must be taken before upper-division courses.</li> <li>No single course may be used to satisfy a major requirement and a minor requirement. A course may be used, however, to satisfy both a major support requirement and a minor requirement.</li> <li>This minor is restricted to students with a declared major outside the Price College of Business.</li> </ul>

Minors are available to all undergraduate students at OU. If the minor is officially declared, successfully completed, and noted on the graduation application, the student's transcript will so indicate at the time the bachelor's degree is posted.
