All non-thesis master's degree programs require <i>at least</i> 32 credit hours.</p> <p>Credit transferred from other institutions must meet specific criteria and is subject to certain limitations.</p> <p>Courses completed through correspondence study may <i>not</i> be applied to the master's degree.</p> <p>To qualify for a graduate degree, students must achieve an overall grade point average of 3.0 or higher in the degree program coursework and in all resident graduate coursework attempted. A student must also have at least a 3.0 in all coursework (including undergraduate coursework if any).</p> <p>*Courses may be satisfied on the basis of previous study with approval of the Graduate Liaison, which must be indicated on the Admission to Candidacy Form. The satisfied hours will be made up via additional elective hours to meet the required total of 47 degree applicable hours.</p>

A student who has done satisfactory graduate work and has earned a 3.0 grade point average may file for master's candidacy.
