SOC 3890 will <i>not</i> count toward this total.</p> <p><b><i>No single course may be used by a student to satisfy a major requirement and a minor requirement.</i></b> A course may be used, however, to satisfy both a major support requirement and a minor requirement.</p> <p>Requests to substitute a minor requirement must be approved in writing by the Department of Sociology.</p>

Minors in the College of Arts & Sciences are available to all undergraduate students at OU. If the minor is officially declared, successfully completed, and noted on the graduation application, the student's transcript will so indicate at the time the bachelor's degree is posted.
