**The requirements for a minor must be completed concurrently with the major degree requirements. No minor may be added by completing courses after receiving the bachelor's degree.**

**REQUIRED COURSES**

1. Language (3 hours) – Third semester foreign language:

2. Social Sciences (6 hours) - Two courses from the following:
  - ANTH 3333; 3883; 4633
  - COMM 2003; 3513; 4513
  - ECON 3333; 3883; 4633
  - GEOG 2603; 3273; 4253; 4263
  - IAS 1303; 2603; 3003 (content based on Latin America); 3313; 3323; 3333; 3353; 3373
  - P SC 2603; 3543; 3653
  
3. Arts and Humanities (6 hours) – Two courses from the following:
  - A HI 3803; 4843
  - FMS 3243
  - HIST 2613; 2623; 3513; 3690; 3703; 3713; 4503; 4553
  - HIST/IAS 4513; 4523; 4533; 4543
  - MLLL 4113; 4123

- At least 6 credit hours must be earned in courses acceptable for residence credit by standards set forth by the Department of International and Area Studies, excluding transfer, correspondence, and examination (AP, CLEP, Advanced Standing) credit.
- Students must successfully complete at least 15 hours of coursework in Latin American Studies, including at least 9 hours at the upper-division level.
- Students are encouraged to study abroad in Latin America. Courses taken while studying abroad may also be substituted to meet minor requirements, though they might not satisfy General Education requirements.
- All courses listed are approved for Latin American Studies, though not all courses have been approved for General Education credit. Students may take other appropriate courses as approved by the Academic Adviser.
- No single course may be used by a student to satisfy a major requirement and a minor requirement. A course may be used, however, to satisfy both a major support requirement and a minor requirement. Requests to substitute a minor requirement must be approved in writing by the Latin American Studies coordinator.
