Courses taken while studying abroad may also be substituted to meet minor requirements, though they might not satisfy General Education requirements. • All courses listed are approved for Russian & East European Studies, though not all courses have been approved for General Education credit. Students may take other appropriate courses as approved by the Academic Adviser. • No single course may be used by a student to satisfy a major requirement and a minor requirement. A course may be used, however, to satisfy both a major support requirement and a minor requirement. Requests to substitute a minor requirement must be approved in writing by the Russian & East European Studies coordinator.

Minors are available to all undergraduate students at OU. If the minor is officially declared, successfully completed, and noted on the graduation application, the student's transcript will so indicate at the time the bachelor's degree is posted.
