<p>Required Courses (6 hours): IAS 5793 Graduate Studies in International Relations</p> <p>Tools of Analysis, Methods, and Statistics (1 course from a list of approved courses.)</p> <p>Core Courses (21 hours): <u>Politics, Government, & Security (9 credit hours)</u> 3 courses from a list of approved courses.</p> <p><u>Substantive Areas (12 hours)</u> A minimum of two courses chosen from an approved list must be taken from two of the following three substantive areas (4 courses total): -Identity, Culture, & Communication -Economics, Environment, & Geography -Regions, Nations, & History</p> <p>Electives (6 hours)</p>	<p>3</p> <p>3</p> <p>21</p> <p>6</p>	<p>The master's degree requires the equivalent of <i>at least</i> two semesters of satisfactory graduate work and additional work as may be prescribed for the degree.</p> <p>All coursework applied to the master's degree must carry graduate credit.</p> <p>Master's degree programs which require a thesis consist of <i>at least</i> 30 credit hours. All non-thesis master's degree programs require <i>at least</i> 32 credit hours.</p> <p>Credit transferred from other institutions must meet specific criteria and is subject to certain limitations.</p> <p>Courses completed through correspondence study may <i>not</i> be applied to the master's degree.</p> <p>To qualify for a graduate degree, students must achieve an overall grade point average of 3.0 or higher in the degree program coursework and in all resident graduate coursework attempted. A student must also have at least a 3.0 in all coursework (including undergraduate coursework if any).</p>

A student who has done satisfactory graduate work and has earned a 3.0 grade point average may file for master's candidacy.
